## Maintaining a Facility for the Future

The facility was built in 1994 to address the needs of a growing County. Recognizing the effectiveness of the technology, the County increased capacity of the facility in 2007 and is investing over \$90M in refurbishment projects to ensure the plant remains a reliable good neighbor for years to come.

These permitted projects include major component replacement, such as corrosion-resistant boiler tubes, new cranes, fire control systems and advanced pollution-control systems designed to meet rigorous environmental standards.
