Hurricane Ian update from Lee County: Debris removal

Fort Myers, FL, Oct. 26, 2022 – Lee County officials and partners today discussed Hurricane Ian debris removal at a workshop that was broadcast on Facebook Live and can be viewed on the county's YouTube channel [here](#). The PowerPoint presentation for the workshop is available [here](#).

The workshop featured updates from Lee County staff as well as the county's debris contractor, a representative of the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) and Lee County Commissioners.

Also announced today: FDEM, in collaboration with Lee County, is now accepting applications from private and commercial property owners who would like assistance for the assessment and removal of qualifying debris, including vehicles, vessels and other title property. In addition, FDEM is accepting applications from owners of vehicles, vessels and other title property lost or displaced due to Hurricane Ian.
