Alternative Source Water & Potable Water Treatment Plants – 5 Water Treatment Plans using Reverse Osmosis, Ion Exchange, Nano-Filtration and Lime Softening.

Water Reclamation & Reuse Irrigation – 5 Water Reclamation Facilities being Converted to Advanced Treatment to Remove Nutrients & Improve Effluent Water Quality, with ~70% of Effluent for Reuse Irrigation.

Field Operations for Distribution & Collections Systems – Maintenance of Source Water, Distribution, Gravity and Force Main Lines, Lift Stations, Water Storage Tanks, Pump Facilities, and Water Meters.

Regulatory Compliance – SFWMD Consumptive Use Permits, FDEP Water & Wastewater, EPA Lead Copper Rule, EPA PFAS in Drinking Water – FDEP Industrial Pre-Treatment
