

Land Development Code:


Require development use alternative design options for irrigation needs.

Amendment Evaluate Reuse Water Distribution **System Connections**

Encourage Expansion of Reuse Infrastructure




Lee Plan:

Consider expanding the County's reuse water infrastructure to areas not currently served. County's expansion reuse water infrastructure will be based on reuse water supply.

Land Development Code:

Require that certain developments provide reuse water infrastructure. when and where available, and that all utility improvements (water, sewer and reuse) are built to County standards.
