Front Desk Volunteers, Education Docents, Trail Guides, Animal Care Volunteers, Clerical Volunteers, Haunted Walk Ghouls and Gremlins, Garden and Trail

Volunteers, Junior Naturalists, and as Members of the Board of Trustees, and

Whereas: In the past year, those volunteers have worked over 10,000 hours to further the mission

of the Calusa Nature Center and Planetarium.
