Dear Mrs. Loibl:

Thank you for your recent letter regarding your request for a ballot initiative to pursue a separate Zip Code for Matlacha for the November ballot. I took the liberty of asking James G. Yaeger, County Attorney, to review your request. Mr. Yaeger, has responded with these comments:

Section 125.01(y) allows the Board to schedule a non-binding straw ballot referendum, however, it states the matter should be of <u>substantial concern</u> within the county. It is Mr. Yaeger's opinion that this term implies the matter should generally relate to concerns of the entire county or at least to a good portion thereof.

There will be a cost to the county of approximately \$1,000.00. While the Supervisor of Elections may place the question on the ballot free of charge, the county pursuant to Section 100.342, F.S., will be required to place two advertised notices of the Referendum in community newspapers (i.e., News-Press, Cape Coral Daily Breeze, etc.).

The subject of the non-binding referendum is on an issue outside the authority of the county, and thus does not present any viable voter sentiment for further county action or have legal effect on the U.S. Postal Service.

It is questionable whether such referendum results would present a persuasive effect any greater than a citizen petition and/or congressional support.

A referendum on this type of issue presents a precedent, which the Board will need to consider if they choose to proceed further.

Because of these concerns, Mr. Yaeger as County Attorney is recommending that the Board consider same by petition and/or Board Resolution of Support, Congressional contacts, etc.

I would like to offer that I would be happy to have the County Attorney's Office prepare a bluesheet item for the Board to adopt a resolution supporting your request for a separate Zip Code for Matlacha. Once the Board has adopted this resolution then I would be happy to send a letter with the adopted resolution to the Honorable Porter Goss, U.S. Congress, the Honorable Bob Graham, U.S. Senate, the Honorable Bill Nelson, U.S Senate, and the U.S. Post Master General John E. Potter.

I strongly believe that the proposal that I have proposed will be just as persuasive of an effort as a non-binding straw ballot referendum. A resolution from the Board will show Congress and the U.S Postal Service that you have strong community support for this effort. Please review with your membership and let me know your thoughts. I can have this item before the board for approval of a resolution in June.


