**AMENDMENT NUMBER 1  
TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN LEE COUNTY AND THE LEE COUNTY SHERIFF

WHEREAS, the County and the Sheriff wish to continue this Agreement with the duties and responsibilities of both Parties unchanged; and,
