MODIFICATION OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AND

Lee County Board of County Commissioners

This Modification is made and entered into by and between the State of Florida, Department of Community Affairs, ("the Department"), and the <u>Lee County Board of County Commissioners</u> ("Recipient") to modify DCA Contract Number <u>03SB-2K-09-46-01-015</u>, dated <u>September 13, 2002</u> ("the Agreement").

WHEREAS, the Department and the Recipient have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Department has provided a grant of \$114,738 to Recipient; and

WHEREAS, additional funds have become available to increase the amount of funding granted to the Recipient.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. Paragraph (16)(a) Funding/Consideration is hereby modified to read as follows:

This is a cost-reimbursement Agreement. The Recipient shall be reimbursed for costs incurred in the satisfactory performance of work hereunder in an amount not to exceed \$155,372 subject to the availability of funds and appropriate budget authority. The Recipient is authorized to incur costs in an amount not to exceed \$116,529 until the Department receives the full budget authority. Upon Department receipt of final budget authority, the parties shall amend the Agreement to authorize the Receipt to incur additional costs. This revised contract amount includes:

- \$\frac{114,738}{2002-2003}\$ CSBG contract allocation
 + \$\frac{35,796}{2003}\$ FY 2003 Award Adjustment
- 3. + \$4,838 Carryover funds from FY 2001-2002
- 2.
