1. REQUESTED MOTION:

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve Bid Waiver #W-030541 to waive the formal quotation procedure and allow the Lee County Division of Public Safety to proceed with the remount/modular refurbishment of four (4) of its ambulances at a cost of \$372,460.00; and the modular refurbishment of three (3) of its ambulances at a cost of \$119,994.00 – total cost: \$492,454.00. The work will be performed by American LaFrance MedicMaster. A waiver has been requested to this vendor, the original manufacturer of these ambulances, in order to keep the 20-year ambulance modular warranty (provided at original purchase) valid. Also approve the expenditure of a not-to-exceed amount of \$75,000.00 to cover any unforeseen damage that may be uncovered during the course of these procedures.

WHY ACTION IS NECESSARY: According to Section 9.4.1 of the Lee County Purchasing & Payment Procedures Manual, approved by the Board on 7/9/02, purchases over \$50,000.00 must be approved by the Board.

WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Allows Public Safety to maintain its ambulance fleet to the prescribed standards; thus maintaining its response time reliability and service to the public.

On April 28, 2003, the Division of Purchasing received a request from the Lee County Division of Public Safety to waive the formal quotation procedure and to proceed with the remount/modular refurbishment of four (4) of its ambulances at a cost of \$372,460.00; and the modular refurbishment of three (3) of its ambulances at a cost of \$119,994.00 – total cost: \$492,454.00. The work will be performed by American LaFrance MedicMaster. A waiver has been requested to this vendor, the original manufacturer of these ambulances, in order to keep the 20-year ambulance modular warranty (provided at original purchase) valid – please see below and attachments. It was also requested by Public Safety that Board approval be obtained for the expenditure of a not-to-exceed amount of \$75,000.00 to cover any unforeseen damage that may be uncovered during the course of these procedures.

According to Section 9.4.1 of the Lee County Purchasing & Payment Procedures Manual, approved by the Board on 7/9/02, purchases over \$50,000.00 must be approved by the Board.

This request for a bid waiver is predicated on, and justified by, the following factors (which have been researched and verified by both Public Safety and Purchasing):

*Modular Warranty. The 20-year ambulance modular warranty (provided at original purchase) will be continued if American LaFrance MedicMaster does the work. If these procedures are performed by any other party, this warranty would be voided.

*Other Warranties. An ambulance is a complicated vehicle; and, as such, comes with a variety of warranties on its systems and components – i.e., electrical, mechanical, paint, etc. Having the work performed by American LaFrance MedicMaster assures that all warranties will continue and not be voided.

*Vendor Performance. Public Safety has a number of MedicMaster ambulances in its fleet; and has been pleased with the vendor's performance and service over the past several years. Consequently, the vendor is familiar with Public Safety's specifications and requirements for its ambulances; knowledge that should make this process move ahead quickly and with minimum delay.

*Chassis Availability. American LaFrance MedicMaster is a Freightliner dealer; and traditionally sells Public Safety the Freightliner chassis for the ambulances at "dealer net". Three out of the four chassis to be used under this project are being sold to Lee County below "dealer net"; with the fourth at "dealer net". Result: Chassis costs are kept to a minimum; bringing down the overall cost of the project.

The purpose of this memo is to respectfully request assistance to secure BoCC approval to proceed with previously budgeted / approved ambulance chassis remounts and refurbishments. EMS recommends using MEDIC MASTER, the original ambulance manufacturer for the following reasons:

- The 20-year ambulance modular warranty (provided at original purchase) will be continued and not voided.
- Additional warranties continue and are not voided (i.e., electrical, mechanical and paint)
- Vendor familiarity with Lee County specifications.
- Satisfactory performance of vendor to date.
- MEDIC MASTER has a model year(s) chassis overstock. This will avoid unnecessary delays and provide Lee County with pricing incentives.

Lee County EMS requests that the BoCC to approve MEDIC MASTER as our sole source ambulance remount / refurbishing vendor with a not to exceed amount of \$492,454. The following table and enclosed specifications detail the amount and types of work we are requesting.

4 - Ambulance Remount / Modular Refurb.	\$372,460
3 - Ambulance Modular Refurbishment	\$119,994

Date: May 1, 2003

As you are aware I have spent many hours over the last year collecting the necessary information in reference to the re-chassis and/or refurbishment of several LCEMS ambulances. This information has also been acquired in the almost daily contacts with ambulance manufacturers that I have had in the past 3 ½ years.

Modular Warranty: Almost without exception, any manufacturer will guarantee or continue the original warranty, if you elect to have the original manufacturer provide the re-chassis / refurb program. In addition, if you allow another manufacturer to alter the original components, the original warranty will be voided.

I have yet to speak with any manufacturer that will warranty or guarantee any component of another manufacturers product. This includes three manufacturers that LCEMS currently utilizes their products.

Workmanship Warranty: Once again, any manufacturer will only warranty the actual work that they perform, not parts or components of another manufacturer. The normal workmanship warranty period is 12 months.

Familiarity: Just as you would not take your Toyota to a Ford dealer for body or mechanical work, the same holds true in the commercial vehicle market.

Based on the above and many other variables, I strongly suggest that we enter into an agreement with MedicMaster for the re-chassis / refurb of 7 MAV ambulances that were originally manufactured by MedicMaster.

In the event that we elect to re-chassis the three Ford AEV ambulances in the future, AEV would be the front runner for this program. However, the past performance, satisfaction and reliability would have to be addressed.

RE: Sole Source Justification

(A) Modular Body Structural Warranty:

Your modular ambulance body has a 20 years warranty. This body is custom designed with special extrusions that are available only to American LaFrance Medicmaster (ALFMM). The methods of constructions are familiar only to ALFMM. The failure to follow each and every method, and procedure will jeopardize the warranty. This is especially true when transferring the body to a new chassis.

The "Exclusions from Warranty" section "G" of your warranty document states:

Remount by anyone other than the Manufacturer or its authorized remount facility.

(B) Ambulance Electrical system:

The electrical system that operates the emergency warning systems, heating and air conditioning, life support systems, interior lighting, exterior lighting, and DOT lighting systems are custom designed by ALFMM. No other company has any knowledge about this system. When you remount an ambulance body on a new chassis this system must be removed, and then interfaced into the new chassis. This is more difficult due to the differences in the original and the new chassis that your modular body is being remounted on. Only the original manufacturer is qualified to do this.

(C) Heating and Air Conditioning System:

A condition of this contract is to replace the heating and air conditioning system in the patient compartment. The contract requires a system identical to the systems installed in your new ALFMM ambulances. This system provides a significant increase in performance. In order to accomplish this every system "electrical, heating, air conditioning, and the modular body" is effected. In addition to the systems mentioned above the forward bulkhead center cabinets will be replaced also. Only ALFMM is qualified to do these modifications, and insure the best results.

I hope this information is lends clarity to this project. Please let me know what I can do if further information is needed.

AERO PRODUCTS CORPORATION warrants to the original owner subject to the provisions, limitations, and conditions set forth in this warranty that the aluminum modular body is structurally sound and free of joint separation, cracks, and all other structural defects of both materials and workmanship and further warrants that it will maintain its structural integrity as long as said body is owned and maintained by the original purchaser.

The sole responsibility of **AMERICAN LAFRANCE MEDICMASTER** under this warranty shall be to replace or repair any defective part at its option. **AMERICAN LAFRANCE MEDICMASTER** shall not be liable for any consequential damages, whatsoever. The warranty period shall begin on the date the vehicle is delivered to the Owner.

Written notice of a claim under this warranty shall be given to **AMERICAN LAFRANCE MEDICMASTER** within a reasonable time after any defect is discovered or should have been discovered.

Exclusions from Warranty.

- A. Any parts or products becoming defective as the result of misuse, negligence, accident or other casualty and/or Owner's failure to provide normal maintenance.
- B. Paint finish, hardware, trims, moldings, windows, interior cabinets, and other appointments or accessories.
- C. Owner's improper installation of components, repairs, or alterations.
- D. Operation in a manner contrary to normal, safe, legal or established practices.
- E. Any part not manufactured by **AMERICAN LAFRANCE MEDICMASTER** along with parts needing replacement due to normal wear.
- F. Should replacement or repair become necessary under the terms of this warranty the extent of that replacement or repair shall be determined solely by **AMERICAN LAFRANCE MEDICMASTER**. Transportation expenses to or from a repair facility, meals, or lodging expenses shall be that of the purchaser and is not an item covered by this warranty.
- G. Remount by anyone other than the Manufacturer or its authorized remount facility.

Conditions:

The chassis offered in this proposal are all offered below "dealer net". I have provided Lt. Jay Bridenthal detailed Freightliner specifications of each chassis. If there is any question concerning pricing of the chassis I would encourage you to check these with a Freightliner dealer.

Remount Proposal # 1 & 2:

These chassis are 2002 chassis that are on hand at the Sanford Plant: These chassis were ordered in January 2002. The customer decided to change to the new Freightliner "M-2" and these became surplus. These are being offered below "dealer net" at 17 month old pricing.

Remount Proposal # 3:

This chassis is a 2001 chassis that is on hand at the Sanford Plant. This chassis was lost in the system at Orlando Freightliner for over a year. We obtained from them. The cost of this chassis is \$49,000.00, and we have offered it for 35,940.00.

Remount Proposal # 4:

The chassis will be a 2004 Model. It is being offered at "dealer net" price of \$46,761.00. This chassis will have to be ordered.

RE: Remount/Refurbish Proposal

Dear Jay:

I thank you for the opportunity to make the following proposal to remount, and refurbish four MedicMaster Emergency Medical Vehicles. This will extend the useful service life of these vehicles for many years. All the units involved in this project are identical in age and design. The scope of the project in regards to items that are worn out or damaged is the same on all units. There are minor differences that will have to be dealt with in each unit. Once the units are received minor problems will be absorbed at no additional cost. If a major problem is found we will have to evaluate it as to cost. Generally this usually is wood rot found after the flooring is pulled out. The improvements to be made are the same on all units.

By allowing American LaFrance MedicMaster to transfer the modular patient compartments to a new chassis will insure the 20-year structural warranty will stay inforce. Transferring a patient compartment module to a new chassis by an unqualified company would terminate the structural warranty. A twelve-month warranty will be provided on work performed remounting, and refurbishing each unit.

I have made three separate proposals. The difference is the Freightliner Chassis in each proposal. I have three new chassis that have never been used. Two 2002 FL-60's were ordered, and after receipt the customer decided to use the new "M2" chassis. The other is a 2001 FL-60 that Orlando Freightliner lost in their system for over a year. The three chassis have a collective savings of \$21,000.00 below cost. The fourth chassis is a new 2003 chassis. I have stopped the sale of the three chassis to other agencies. I will need a commitment on them to prevent their sale.

Proposal # 2: Remount # 3 - \$87,620.00 each
Proposal # 3: Remount # 4 - \$96,926.90 each
