On March 16, 1999, the BOCC approved the original agreement with Robins Roost Phase 1 Homeowners Association which provided for effluent reuse for irrigation of their common green areas at a cost of \$0.21 per 1,000 gallons, and a monthly average flow of .05 million gallons per day, with the maximum amount of water available to the user under adverse conditions of 50,000 gallons per day.  On July 9, 2002, the BOCC approved, by Resolution No. 02-07-44, revised utilities rates and charges, increasing the reclaimed effluent reuse charge to \$0.25 per 1,000 gallons.  The attached amendment revises the reuse charge to the current amount of \$0.25 per 1,000 gallons, and revises the monthly average flow to 0.016 millions gallons per day with the maximum amount of water available to the user under adverse conditions of 32,000 gallons per day. # AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT FOR "THE DELIVERY AND USE OF RECLAIMED WATER" RECORDED IN O.R. BOOK 3094 PAGES 1991 – 2006

WHEREAS, Robins Roost Phase 1 Homeowners Association (herein after referred to as "USER") entered into an agreement entitled "Agreement for the Delivery and Use of Reclaimed Effluent Water" (Recorded in O.R. Book 3094, Pages 1991 – 2006), dated March 16, 1999, (herein after referred to as "1999 Agreement"), with Lee County, a political subdivision in the State of Florida (herein after referred to as "COUNTY"); and,

WHEREAS, The COUNTY passed and adopted Resolution number 02-07-44 on July 9, 2002 raising the reclaimed water rate from \$0.21 to \$0.25 per 1,000 gallons; and,

WHEREAS, The original 1999 agreement established a billing methodology that allotted a monthly average flow of 0.05 million gallons per day to the user; and,

WHEREAS, The USER and the COUNTY desire to amend the original Agreement to encourage conservation of reclaimed water.

NOW, THEREFORE in consideration of the foregoing, it is the intent of ROBINS ROOST PHASE I HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION and the COUNTY to make this Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement in order to agree as follows:

## Section 14 is amended to read:

For furnishing of reclaimed water, the COUNTY'S current charge is \$0.25 per 1,000 gallons. The COUNTY shall bill the USER monthly on the number of gallons used. Payment shall be made to the COUNTY within 30 days following receipt of the bill.

# Quantity of Reclaimed Water in Exhibit B is amended to read:

The COUNTY will deliver and the USER shall accept a monthly average flow of 0.016 million gallons per day (MGD) reclaimed water. Availability of the reclaimed water shall be determined by the COUNTY based upon: flow into the treatment facility, quality of reclaimed water, and/or priority level as established in the Agreement. The maximum rate available to the USER, under these adverse conditions, will be twice the average daily flow rate of 0.016 M.G.D., or 32,000 G.P.D. If the USER desires an increase in allocation the USER shall submit a request in writing to the COUNTY for approval prior to the maximum allocation being exceeded.
