The project includes the excavation, transportation, placement and grading of sand. The project also includes the planting of vegetation and the placement of pedestrian access points along the dune, as well as site restoration at the completion of project construction. 2. The purpose of this Memorandum is to recommend that Lee County, Florida award a construction contract to Lake Michigan Contractors (LMC) for the Bonita Beach Renourishment Project, for construction commencing mid-December 2003.

Our review of the submitted bid package by the lowest bidder, a bid tabulation check, and conversations with both the provided references and randomly selected contacts from Completed Projects lists revealed the following:

- All three respondents correctly tabulated their bids, with LMC submitting the lowest responsive bid for the project;
- The submitted bid by Lake Michigan Contractors of \$1,659,576 is within the project estimate of \$2,100,000 provided by the County;
- Reference contacts made by ATM to two separate municipalities and two separate U.S. Army Corps of Engineers districts indicate that the Contractor maintained good safety and project site clean-up practices;
- Reference contacts indicate that Lake Michigan Contractors performed responsibly, within budget, and without unavoidable resultant damage to environmental resources; and,
- The contractor failed to list a potential sub-contractor to perform the surveying tasks.

ATM recommends that Lake Michigan Contractors be awarded the construction contract to perform the construction of the Bonita Beach Renourishment Project. This recommendation of award is contingent upon Lake Michigan Contractors submitting to Lee County, in writing, the name(s) of the Subcontractor firm(s)

intended to conduct the surveying components of the Bonita Beach Renourishment Project.

Based in part upon satisfactory completion of the Bonita Beach Renourishment Project construction by Lake Michigan Contractors, it will be Lee County's decision (and responsibility) to negotiate and issue a Change Order to engage Lake Michigan Contractors and their Subcontractors, Assigns, etc. to perform work on the Lover's Key Beach Restoration Project.
