9. Background:

During FY05 the park and ride was a great success and the Summerlin Square shopping center parking lot did not have the capacity to accommodate the cars from the passengers parking there and riding the trolley to Ft. Myers Beach. On an emergency basis, the shopping center provided LeeTran at no cost the parking area adjacent to the shopping center to use for the park and ride. The relocation of the park and ride was done with little notice. This parcel is available again this year to lease, and the cost is \$15,000 from January 19, 2006 through April 22, 2006.

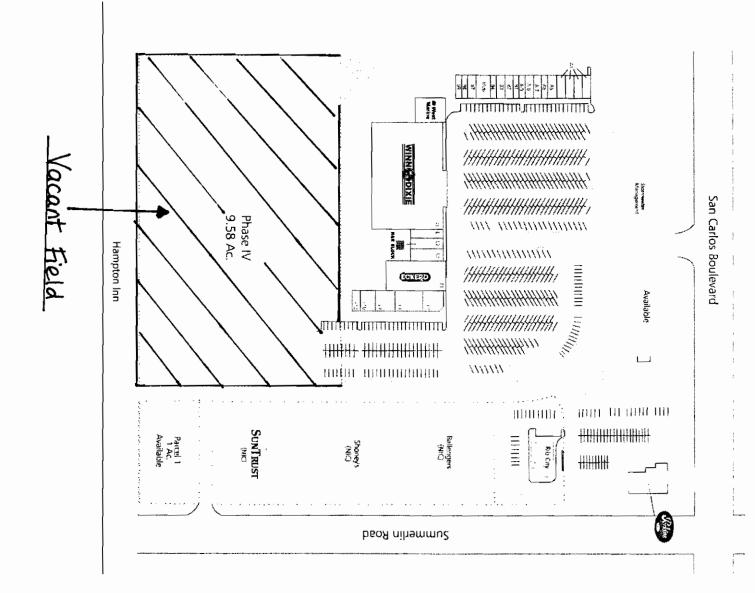
