**1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE:** Award B-06-18 EXOTIC PLANT REMOVAL AT DEEP LAGOON PRESERVE to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder, Greenwerx Groundskeeping, Inc., for a total contract amount of \$193,750.0, with a total project completion time 90 days, with follow-up treatments after approximately one (1) year. Also, authorize Chairwoman to execute agreement upon receipt. This project will be partially funded by a grant from the Division of Forestry. This project was anticipated and funds are available.

**2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES:** Provides Lee County with a Contractor to remove exotics plants in the Deep Lagoon Preserve area, by mowing followed by herbicide. There will be three areas to be treated; followed by a second treatment within six (6) months to one years' time.

**3. MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATION:** Approval recommended.
