



1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Award B-06-34 TRANSPORT OF NON-HAZARDOUS LEACHATE, for the Solid Waste Division, to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder meeting all bidding requirements; Karle Enviro-Organic Recycling, for the lump sum amounts of \$6.30/ton for transport to Commerce Park and \$6.30/ton for transport to the Immokalee WWTP. This contract is for a period of two (2) years with two (2) one (1) year renewal options. Authorize Chairwoman to execute the contract upon receipt.

2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES: Provides Lee County with a hauler for the transport of non-hazardous leachate.

9. BACKGROUND:

The Solid Waste Division submitted a request to Contracts Management to obtain bids for the Transport of Non-Hazardous Leachate. The anticipated annual cost (approximately \$200,000.00) of the project required the use of the formal advertised sealed bid procedure.

On the bidding deadline of September 20, 2006, Contracts Management received two (2) bids. The bids have been reviewed by the Solid Waste Division and it is being recommended that award be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder meeting all bidding requirements, Karle Enviro-Organic Recycling, Inc. for the lump sum amounts of \$6.30/ton for transport to Commerce Park and \$6.30/ton for transport to the Immokalee WWTP. This contract is for a period of two (2) years with two (2) one (1) year renewal options.
