- 1. ACTION REQUESTED/PURPOSE: Hear Bid Protest and consider award of Formal Quotation No. Q-060449, Traffic Cable and Installation for DOT, to the low quoter meeting specifications, Fiber Solutions of S.W. Florida, at the prices on the attached tab sheet. The initial term of this quote is one year; also request authority to renew this quote for four additional one-year periods, at the same terms and conditions, if in the best interest of Lee County; and to exercise the price escalator clause as per the specifications on an as-needed basis. Lee County DOT estimates annual expenditures at approximately \$150,000. Funding will be available from the individual department or division's budget whom will be responsible for monitoring their individual expenditures.
- **2. WHAT ACTION ACCOMPLISHES:** Pursuant to the Lee County Purchasing and Payment Procedures Manual, the Board will hear presentations by the protesting parties and may then decide which quote is in the best interest of Lee County, with articulated reasons for the decision. Ultimately, this purchase will provide DOT with traffic cable and installation services within Lee County.
- **3. MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATION:** Approve as stated; upholding the Dispute Committee's recommendation (please see Background); and proceed with the award to Fiber Solutions of S.W. Florida.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

Sealed Quotations will be received by the DIVISION OF PURCHASING, until 2:30pm on the date specified on the cover sheet of this "Request for Quotations", and opened immediately thereafter by the Purchasing Director or designee.

Any question regarding this solicitation should be directed to the Buyer listed on the cover page of this solicitation, or by calling the Division of Purchasing at (239) 344-5450.

1. SUBMISSION OF QUOTE:

- a. Quotations shall be sealed in an envelope, and the outside of the envelope should be marked with the following information:
 - 1. Marked with the words "Sealed Ouote"
 - 2. Name of the firm submitting the quotation
 - 3. Title of the quotation
 - 4. Quotation number
- b. The Quotation shall be submitted in triplicate as follows:
 - 1. The original consisting of the Lee County quotes forms completed and signed.
 - 2. A copy of the original quote forms for the Purchasing Director.
 - 3. A second copy of the original quote forms for use by the requesting department.
- c. The following should be submitted along with the quotation in a separate envelope. This envelope should be marked as described above, but instead of marking the envelope as "Sealed Quote", please indicate the contents; i.e., literature, drawings, submittals, etc. This information should be submitted in duplicate.
 - 1. Any information (either required or in addition to that asked for by the specifications) necessary to analyze your quotation; i.e., required submittals, literature, technical data, financial statements.
 - 2. Warranties and guarantees against defective materials and workmanship.
- d. **ALTERNATE QUOTE:** If the vendor elects to submit more than one quote, then the quotes should be submitted in separate envelopes and marked as indicated above. The second, or alternate quote should be marked as "Alternate".

- e. **QUOTES RECEIVED LATE:** It is the quoter's responsibility to ensure that his quote is received by the Division of Purchasing prior to the opening date and time specified. Any quote received after the opening date and time will be promptly returned to the quoter unopened. Lee County will not be responsible for quotes received late because of delays by a third party delivery service; i.e., U.S. Mail, UPS, Federal Express, etc.
- f. QUOTE CALCULATION ERRORS: In the event there is a discrepancy between the total quoted amount or the extended amounts and the unit prices quoted, the unit prices will prevail and the corrected sum will be considered the quoted price.
- g. **PAST PERFORMANCE:** All vendors will be evaluated on their past performance and prior dealings with Lee County (i.e., failure to meet specifications, poor workmanship, late delivery, etc.).
- h. **WITHDRAWAL OF QUOTE:** No quote may be withdrawn for a period of 90 days after the scheduled time for receiving quotes. A quote may be withdrawn prior to the quote-opening date and time. Such a request to withdraw should be made in writing to the Purchasing Director, who will approve or disapprove of the request.
- i. **COUNTY RESERVES THE RIGHT:** The County reserves the right to waive minor informalities in any quote; to reject any or all quotes with or without cause; and/or to accept the quote that in its judgment will be in the best interest of the County of Lee.
- j. **EXECUTION OF QUOTE:** All quotes shall contain the signature of an authorized representative of the quoter in the space provided on the quote proposal form. All quotes shall be typed or printed in ink. The bidder may not use erasable ink. All corrections made to the quote shall be initialed.

2. ACCEPTANCE

The materials and/or services delivered under the quote **shall** remain the property of the seller until a physical inspection and actual usage of these materials and/or services is accepted by the County and is to be in compliance with the terms herein, fully in accord with the specifications and of the highest quality. In the event the materials and/or services supplied to the County are found to be defective or do not conform to specifications, the County reserves the right to cancel the order upon written notice to the seller and return such product to the seller at the seller's expense.

3. **SUBSTITUTIONS**

Whenever in these specifications a brand name or make is mentioned, it is the intention of the County only to establish a grade or quality of materials and not to rule out other brands or makes of equality. However, if a product other than that specified is quote, it is the vendor's responsibility to name such product with his quote and to prove to the County that said product is equal to the product specified. Lee County shall be the sole judge as to whether a product being offered by the quoter is actually equivalent to the one being specified by the detailed specifications. (Note: This paragraph does not apply when it is determined that the technical requirements of this solicitation require only a specific product as stated in the detailed specifications.)

4. RULES, REGULATIONS, LAWS, ORDINANCES & LICENSES

The awarded vendor shall observe and obey all laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations, of the federal, state, and local government, which may be applicable to the supply of this product or service.

- a. Occupational License Vendor shall submit within 10 calendar days after request.
- b. Specialty License(s) Vendor shall possess at the time of the opening of the quote all necessary permits and/or license required for the sale of this product and/or service and upon the request of the County provide copies of licenses and/or permits within 10 calendar days after request.

5. **WARRANTY/GUARANTY** (unless otherwise specified)

All materials and/or services furnished under this quote shall be warranted by the vendor to be free from defects and fit for the intended use.

6. **PRE-BID CONFERENCE**

A pre-bid conference will be held at the location, date, and time specified on the cover of this solicitation. Pre-bid conferences are generally <u>non-mandatory</u>, but it is highly recommended that everyone planning to submit a quote attend.

In the event a pre-bid conference is classified as <u>mandatory</u>, it will be so specified on the cover of this solicitation and it will be the responsibility of the quoter to ensure that they are represented at the pre-bid. Only those quoters who attend the pre-bid conference will be allowed to quote on this project.

7. <u>BIDDERS LIST MAINTENANCE</u>

A bidder should respond to "Request for Quotations" in order to be kept on the Bidder's List. Failure to respond to three different "request for quotations" may result in the vendor being removed from the Bidder's List. A bidder may do one of the following, in order to respond properly to the request:

- a. Submission of a quotation prior to the quote receipt deadline.
- b. Submission of a "no bid" notice prior to the quote receipt deadline.

8. <u>LEE COUNTY PAYMENT PROCEDURES</u>

All vendors are requested to mail one original invoice and one invoice copy to:

All invoices will be paid as directed by the Lee County payment procedure unless otherwise differently stated in the detailed specification portion of this quote.

Lee county will not be liable for request of payment deriving from aid, assistance, or help by any individual, vendor, quoter, or bidder for the preparation of these specifications.

Lee County is generally a tax-exempt entity subject to the provisions of the 1987 legislation regarding sales tax on services. Lee County will pay those taxes for which it is obligated, or it will provide a Certificate of Exemption furnished by the Department of Revenue. All contractors or quoters should include in their quote all sales or use taxes, which they will pay when making purchases of material or subcontractor's services.

9. <u>LEE COUNTY BID PROTEST PROCEDURE</u>

Any contractor/vendor/firm that has submitted a formal bid/quote/proposal to Lee County, and who is adversely affected by an intended decision with respect to the award of the formal bid/quote/proposal, shall file with the County's Purchasing Director or Public Works Director a written "Notice of Intent to File a Protest" not later than seventy-two (72) hours (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Legal Holidays) after receipt of a "Notice of Intended Decision" from the County with respect to the proposed award of the formal bid/quote/proposal.

The "Notice of Intent to File a Protest" is one of two documents necessary to perfect Protest. The second document is the "Formal Written Protest", both documents are described below.

The "Notice of Intent to File a Protest" document shall state all grounds claimed for the Protest, and clearly indicate it as the "Notice of Intent to File a Protest". Failure to clearly indicate the Intent to file the Protest shall constitute a waiver of all rights to seek any further remedies provided for under this Protest Procedure.

The "Notice of Intent to File a Protest" shall be received ("stamped in") by the Purchasing Director or Public Works Director not later than Four o'clock (4:00) PM on the third working day following the day of receipt of the County's Notice of Intended Decision.

The affected party shall then file its Formal Written Protest within ten (10) calendar days after the time for the filing of the Notice of Intent to File a Protest has expired. Except as provided for in the paragraph below, upon filing of the Formal Written Protest, the contractor/vendor/firm shall post a bond, payable to the Lee County Board of County Commissioners in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid/quote/proposal, or Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), whichever is less. Said bond shall be designated and held for payment of any costs that may be levied against the protesting contractor/vendor/firm by the Board of County Commissioners, as the result of a frivolous Protest.

A clean, Irrevocable Letter of Credit or other form of approved security, payable to the County, may be accepted. Failure to submit a bond, letter of credit, or other approved security simultaneously with the Formal Written Protest shall invalidate the protest, at which time the County may continue its procurement process as if the original "Notice of Intent to File a Protest" had never been filed.

Any contractor/vendor/firm submitting the County's standard bond form (CSD: 514), along with the bid/quote/proposal, shall not be required to submit an additional bond with the filing of the Formal Written Protest.

The Formal Written Protest shall contain the following:

- County bid/quote/proposal identification number and title.
- Name and address of the affected party, and the title or position of the person submitting the Protest.
- A statement of disputed issues of material fact. If there are no disputed material facts, the Formal Protest must so indicate.
- A concise statement of the facts alleged, and of the rules, regulations, statues, or constitutional provisions, which entitle the affected party to relief.

- All information, documents, other materials, calculations, and any statutory or case law authority in support of the grounds for the Protest.
- A statement indicating the relief sought by the affected (protesting) party.
- Any other relevant information that the affected party deems to be material to Protest.

Upon receipt of a timely filed "Notice of Intent to File a Protest", the Purchasing Director or Public Works Director (as appropriate) may abate the award of the formal bid/quote/proposal as appropriate, until the Protest is heard pursuant to the informal hearing process as further outlined below, except and unless the County Manager shall find and set forth in writing, particular facts and circumstances that would require an immediate award of the formal bid/quote/proposal for the purpose of avoiding a danger to the public health, safety, or welfare. Upon such written finding by the County Manager, the County Manager may authorize an expedited Protest hearing procedure. The expedited Protest hearing shall be held within ninety-six (96) hours of the action giving rise to the contractor/vendor/firm's Protest, or as soon as may be practicable for all parties. The "Notice of Intent to File a Protest" shall serve as the grounds for the affected party's presentation and the requirements for the submittal of a formal, written Protest under these procedures, to include the requirement for a bond, shall not apply.

The Dispute Committee shall conduct an informal hearing with the protesting contractor/vendor/firm to attempt to resolve the Protest, within seven working days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays) from receipt of the Formal Written Protest. The Chairman of the Dispute Committee shall ensure that all affected parties may make presentations and rebuttals, subject to reasonable time limitations, as appropriate. The purpose of the informal hearing by the Dispute Committee, the protestor and other affected parties is to provide and opportunity: (1) to review the basis of the Protest; (2) to evaluate the facts and merits of the Protest: and (3) to make a determination whether to accept or reject the Protest.

Once a determination is made by the Dispute Committee with respect to the merits of the Protest, the Dispute Committee shall forward to the Board of County Commissioners its recommendations, which shall include relevant background information related to the procurement.

Upon receiving the recommendation from the Dispute Committee, the Board of County Commissioners shall conduct a hearing on the matter at a regularly scheduled meeting. Following presentations by the affected parties, the Board shall render its decision on the merits of the Protest.

If the Board's decision upholds the recommendation by the Dispute Committee regarding the award, and further finds that the Protest was either frivolous and/or lacked merit, the Board, at its discretion, may assess costs, charges, or damages associated with any delay of the award, or any costs incurred with regard to the protest. These costs, charges or damages may be deducted from the security (bond or letter of credit) provided by the contractor/vendor/firm. Any costs, charges or damages assessed by the Board in excess of the security shall be paid by the protesting contractor/vendor/firm within thirty (30) calendar days of the Board's final determination concerning the award.

All formal bid/quote/proposal solicitations shall set forth the following statement:

"FAILURE TO FOLLOW THE BID PROTEST PROCEDURE REQUIREMENTS WITHIN THE TIMEFRAMES AS PRESCRIBED HEREIN AND ESTABLISHED BY LEE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FLORIDA, SHALL CONSTITUTE A WAIVER OF YOUR PROTEST AND ANY RESULTING CLAIMS."

10. PUBLIC ENTITY CRIME

Any person or affiliate as defined by statute who has been placed on the convicted vendor list following a conviction for a public entity crime may not submit a bid or a contract to provide any goods or services to the County; may not submit a bid on a contract with the County for the construction or repair of a public building or a public work; may not submit bids or leases of real property to the County; may not be awarded or perform works as a contractor, supplier, subcontractor, or consultant under a contract with the County, and may not transact business with the County in excess of \$25,000.00 for a period of 36 months from the date of being placed on the convicted vendor list.

11. **QUALIFICATION OF QUOTERS** (unless otherwise noted)

Quotes will be considered only from firms normally engaged in the sale and distribution or provision of the services as specified herein. Quoters shall have adequate organization, facilities, equipment, and personnel to ensure prompt and efficient service to Lee County. The County reserves the right before recommending any award to inspect the facilities and organization; or to take any other action necessary to determine ability to perform is satisfactory, and reserves the right to reject quotes where evidence submitted or investigation and evaluation indicates an inability of the quoter to perform.

12. MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS

In accordance with Chapter 443 of the Florida Statues, it is the vendor's responsibility to provide Lee County with Materials Safety Data Sheets on quoted materials, as may apply to this procurement.

13. MISCELLANEOUS

If a conflict exists between the General Conditions and the detailed specifications, then the detailed specifications shall prevail.

14. WAIVER OF CLAIMS

Once this contract expires, or final payment has been requested and made, the awarded contractor shall have no more than 30 days to present or file any claims against the County concerning this contract. After that period, the County will consider the Contractor to have waived any right to claims against the County concerning this agreement.

15. AUTHORITY TO PIGGYBACK

It is hereby made a precondition of any quote and a part of these specifications that the submission of any quote in response to this request constitutes a quote made under the same conditions, for the same price, and for the same effective period as this quote, to any other governmental entity.

16. COUNTY RESERVES THE RIGHT

a) State Contract

If applicable, the County reserves the right to purchase any of the items in this quote from State Contract Vendors if the prices are deemed lower on State Contract than the prices we receive in this quotation.

b) Any Single Large Project

The County, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to separately quote any project that is outside the scope of this quote, whether through size, complexity, or dollar value.

c) <u>Disadvantaged Business Enterprises</u>

The County, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to purchase any of the items in this quote from Disadvantage Business Enterprise vendor if the prices are determined to be in the best interest of the County, to assist the

County in the fulfillment of any of the County's grant commitments to federal or state agencies.

The County further reserves the right to purchase any of the items in this quote from DBE's to fulfill the County's state policy toward DBE's as outlined in County Ordinance 88-45 and 90-04, as amended.

d) Anti-Discrimination

The vendor for itself, its successors in interest, and assignees, as part of the consideration there of covenant and agree that:

In the furnishing of services to the County hereunder, no person on the grounds of race, religion, color, age, sex, national origin, handicap or marital status shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination.

The vendor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, religion, color, age, sex, national origin, handicap or marital status. The vendor will make affirmative efforts to insure that applicants are employed and that employees are treated during employment without regard to their race, religion, color, age, sex, national origin, handicap or marital status. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, acts of employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment advertising; layoff or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

Vendor agrees to post in a conspicuous place, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices setting forth the provisions of this anti-discrimination clause.

Vendor will provide all information and reports required by relevant regulations and/or applicable directives. In addition, the vendor shall permit access to its books, records, accounts, other sources of information, and its facilities as may be determined by the County to be pertinent to ascertain compliance. The vendor shall maintain and make available relevant data showing the extent to which members of minority groups are beneficiaries under these contracts.

Where any information required of the vendor is in the exclusive possession of another who fails ore refuses to furnish this information, the vendor shall so certify to the County its effort made toward obtaining said information. The vendor shall remain obligated under this paragraph until the expiration of three (3) years after the termination of this contract.

In the event of breach of any of the above anti-discrimination covenants, the County shall have the right to impose sanctions as it may determine to be appropriate, including withholding payment to the vendor or canceling, terminating, or suspending this contract, in whole or in part.

Additionally, the vendor may be declared ineligible for further County contracts by rule, regulation or order of the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County, or as otherwise provided by law.

The vendor will send to each union, or representative of workers with which the vendor has a collective bargaining agreement or other contract of understanding, a notice informing the labor union of worker's representative of the vendor's commitments under this assurance, and shall post copies of the notice in conspicuous places available to the employees and the applicants for employment.

The vendor will include the provisions of this section in every subcontract under this contract to insure its provisions will be binding upon each subcontractor. The vendor will take such actions with respect to any subcontractor, as the contracting agency may direct, as a means of enforcing such provisions, including sanctions for non-compliance.

17. <u>AUDITABLE RECORDS</u>

The awarded vendor shall maintain auditable records concerning the procurement adequate to account for all receipts and expenditures, and to document compliance with the specifications. These records shall be kept in accordance with generally accepted accounting methods, and Lee County reserves the right to determine the record-keeping method required in the event of non-conformity. These records shall be maintained for two years after completion of the project and shall be readily available to County personnel with reasonable notice, and to other persons in accordance with the Florida Public Disclosure Statues.

18. **DRUG FREE WORKPLACE**

Whenever two or more quotes/proposals, which are equal with respect to price, quality and service, are received for the procurement of commodities or contractual services, a quote/proposal received from a business that certifies that it has implemented a drug-free workplace program shall be given preference in the award process. In order to have a drug-free workplace program, a business shall comply with the requirements of Florida Statutes 287.087.

19. REQUIRED SUBMITTALS

Any submittals requested should be returned with the quote response. This information may be accepted after opening, but no later than 10 calendar days after request.

20. TERMINATION

Any agreement as a result of this quote may be terminated by either party giving thirty (30) calendar days advance written notice. The County reserves the right to accept or not accept a termination notice submitted by the vendor, and no such termination notice submitted by the vendor shall become effective unless and until the vendor is notified in writing by the County of its acceptance.

The Purchasing Director may immediately terminate any agreement as a result of this quote for emergency purposes, as defined by the Lee County Purchasing and Payment Procedure Manual.

Any vendor who has voluntarily withdrawn from a formal quote/proposal without the County's mutual consent during the contract period shall be barred from further County procurement for a period of 180 days. The vendor may apply to the Board of Lee County Commissioners for waiver of this debarment. Such application for waiver of debarment must be coordinated with and processed by Purchasing.

21. **CONFIDENTIALITY**

Firms and their agents who intend to submit qualifications, or have submitted qualifications, for this project are hereby placed on *formal notice* that they are *not* to contact County personnel for such purposes as holding meetings of introduction, meals, or meetings relating to the selection process outside of those specifically scheduled by the County for negotiations. Any such lobbying activities may cause immediate disqualification for this project.

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23. **INSURANCE (AS APPLICABLE)**

Insurance shall be provided, per the attached insurance guide. Upon request, an insurance certificate complying with the attached guide may be required prior to award.

LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS FOR TRAFFIC CABLE AND INSTALLATION

SECTION I-GENERAL INFORMATION

SCOPE

The intent of this quote is to provide the purchase and installation of Traffic Cable for various Lee County departments and divisions.

TERM OF QUOTE

This quote shall be in effect for one-year, or until new quotes are taken and awarded. This quote, or any portion thereof, has the option of being renewed for four additional one-year periods, upon mutual agreement of all parties, under the same terms and conditions.

WORKMANSHIP

All work shall be done by skilled mechanics in accordance with BICSI standard practices and in a manner acceptable to the County. All fiber will be tested and certified and printed test reports will be provided. Worksite should be left in a neat and orderly condition. All cable should be properly installed and contained. Any work not conforming to these specifications shall be corrected to the satisfaction of the County. Such corrections shall be made at the expense of the contractor.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The equipment provided under these specifications shall be new and unused. All wire frames, racks, punch blocks, jacks, plugs, duct, connectors, other materials, labor and other necessary items to perform this job will be supplied by the awarded vendor unless specifically noted herein or other arrangements made.

All copper and fiber cabling runs will be tested and follow the industry standards for Category 6 installation, testing and acceptance.

The cable must meet the requirements of the National Electrical Code (NEC) section 770. Please see ATTACHMENT A.

All wiring runs will be documented at termination points and other intermediary locations, with all necessary information, including far-end punch blocks or patch panels and the station locations. Complete documentation of all cabling and test results will be displayed at IDF room and delivered to Lee County at the completion of the project. All installations shall be tested and test results shall be provided. Where fiber or copper runs provide connection to new or existing network equipment facilities, operational testing of the network and/or other connected equipment shall be completed with a representative present.

Documentation shall be placed in field cabinets describing connections and network. Splice trays and fiber patch cords shall be labeled. Documentation shall be provided in pdf and MS VISIO compatible format. A fiber cable allocation table shall be provided to summarize the utilization of fiber strands by strand number, color and tube.

The vendor will fire caulk all sleeves and penetration required for cable installation. Vendor will provide sleeves with end bushings for project as needed. All fire walls require penetrations to be sleeved. Size of sleeves shall be determined based on quantities of cables need for serviced area. Please see ATTACHMENT B and ATTACHMENT C.

Underground locates shall be requested and no work shall be initiated before locations of underground utilities and any conflicts are identified.

WARRANTY

All work performed shall be warranted for a minimum period of one year after acceptance by the County. Cable and all other equipment installed will carry the manufacturer's warranty and be warranted to the County.

CERTIFICATION

A minimum of one (1) member of the awarded vendor's staff must hold a current RCDD certification. Should the employment status of the person with the certification change Lee County must be notified immediately.

SUPERVISION AND SAFETY

The contractor shall be responsible for the supervision and direction of the work performed by his employees and subcontractors; and shall, at all times provide a full time manager or crew leader on the premises to carry out the responsibility. The manager or crew leader shall have the authority to act as agent for the contractor in his absence, and shall be fully qualified to implement the contract specifications. The contractor shall be responsible for instructing his employees in all safety measures. All equipment used by the contractor shall be maintained in safe operating condition at all times, free from defects or wear which may in any way constitute a hazard to any person or persons on County property. Kent Technologies hereby notifies Lee County that it intends to protest the award for Q-060449, Traffic Cable and Installation, made September 7, 2006.

Our grounds for this protest include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Kent Technologies complies with requirements for the Corning Extended Warranty Program (EWP). Kent Technologies is fully authorized to participate in the program and offer the EWP to all customers and for all projects that are eligible for coverage under Corning's warranty programs. Kent obtained said authorization and compliance by agreement with Corning Cable Systems in advance of submitting our bid response to Lee County. Kent has continued to meet the terms our agreement, including the use of Corning professional services where applicable and obtaining all requisite Corning training and certifications. Kent understands that Corning sent an email to Lee County on September 8, 2006 further clarifying the Corning warranty program and Kent's authorization to offer the same.
- 2. Pursuant to Corning's EWP rules, no Extended Warranty Program Member (including Fiber Solutions) is eligible to authorize or offer the EWP for projects or systems other than those installed in a Private Network or as a Premise Cabling Solution. Specifically, installations that are part of Lee County's Traffic Control Systems, ATMS or ITS communication infrastructures are not eligible for coverage under the Corning EWP. Therefore, notwithstanding Kent's authorization to offer the Corning EWP as clarified in item one above, we further contend that the EWP requirement is not applicable with respect to the RFP intent and purpose. Accordingly, a rejection of our bid response based on an EWP requirement would needlessly exclude Kent from an opportunity to service Lee County and overly restrict our ability to perform work on a contract that we are fully trained, qualified and experienced to do.

Formal Written Protest Q-060449 Traffic Cable and Installation

Kent Technologies hereby submits the following formal written protest to Lee County in protest of the award for Q-060449, Traffic Cable and Installation, made September 7, 2006.

Summary of Material Facts and Disputed Issues

- A. Lee County publicly released RFQ #Q-060449, Traffic Cable and Installation with a response due date of July 18, 2006 no later than 2:30 PM.
- B. The basis for award is the "overall low quoter (Grand Total) meeting specifications."
- C. In addition to various vendor qualifications contained under Section II of the RFQ, Subsection 2 Corning Cable contained the follow items:
 - a. Vendor must be able to provide Corning brand fiber cable.
 - b. Vendor must be an authorized Extended Warranty Partner with Corning. (please provide certificate)
 - c. Vendor must have Corning Design Course (TR-07-S) Certification. (please provide certificate)
 - d. Vendor must have Corning Installation Course (TR-02) Certification. (please provide certificate)
- D. Kent Technologies responded to RFQ #Q-060449 July 18, 2006 before 2:30 PM
- E. Kent's quote was the lowest of the following three respondents:

a. Kent Technologies -

\$2,679.41

b. Precision Contracting Services -

\$3,640.80

c. Fiber Solutions -

\$4,099.08

F. Kent complied with the requirements set forth in the RFQ and responded in accordance to Subsection 2 – Corning Cable by way of a valid and current Extended Warranty Program member option extended to Kent by Corning and by presentation of the current and correct course certifications.

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- G. Kent received a faxed copy of the Intent to Award Quote #Q-060449 letter on September 7, 2006 advising of the award decision as follows:
 - a. Kent Technologies quotation Rejected because Kent did not have an Extended Warranty Program (EWP).
 - b. Precision Contracting quotation Rejected because Precision did not have an office within 50 miles of Lee County.
 - c. Fiber Solutions quotation determined as meeting all specification and awarded the contract.
- H. Therefore, Kent Technologies formally protest the rejection of our quotation and subsequent award decision based on the following facts:
 - a. Kent did have a valid Extended Warranty Program (EWP) in effect and agreement in place with Corning, and continues to have the same in place, authorizing Kent to fully participate and extend the Extended Warranty Program to its customers for installations eligible for coverage under the EWP. Accordingly, Kent should be rightfully awarded the subject Traffic Cable and Installation contract.
 - b. The EWP is not available or relevant to customer projects others than "Private Network or Premise Cabling Solution" installations. Specifically, installations that are part of Lee County's Traffic Control Systems, ATMS or ITS communication infrastructures are not eligible for coverage under the Corning EWP. In fact, no EWP member can extend or offer the EWP for Lee County Traffic Control System installations. Therefore, not withstanding the EWP in effect and authorization extended to Kent by Corning in item H(a) above, Kent contends that its quotation should also not be rejected for reasons of a specific extended warranty program association that is not relevant or available with respect to the products, installations, systems or work required under the Traffic Cable and Installation contract.

Additional Facts, Information, Clarifications and Ground for Protest

Our facts, information, clarifications, and grounds for this protest include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. The status of "authorized Extended Warranty Partner" as specified in the RFQ does not exist. The correct designation for Corning's warranty program is an Extended Warranty Program (EWP) member; also referred to as Certified Member. (See Exhibit-1 in this response, and Page-21 of the Q-060449 RFQ)
- 2. The required training courses/certifications specified in the RFQ are no longer available. The current courses and respective certifications held by Kent are as follows:
 - a. TS-LAN-400 replaces TR-07
 - b. TS-LAN-Design-500 replaces TR-02

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- c. The TS designations are current Corning training courses/certifications. The TR designations are legacy Corning/Siecor training courses/certifications that are no longer available.
- 3. The disqualification criteria contained in the Intent to Award Quote #Q-060449 dated September 7, 2006 that states "Kent does not have an Extended Warranty Program" is materially and factually incorrect. (See Exhibit-2)
- 4. Kent is in fact eligible and authorized to participate as a Corning Extended Warranty Program (EWP) member. As an Extended Warranty Program member, Kent is certified for installation of Corning products and authorized to offer the EWP to specified customers for projects and installations eligible for coverage under Corning's warranty programs. (See Exhibits 3 and 4.)
 - a. Kent obtained said authorization and membership compliance by agreement with Corning Cable Systems in advance of submitting our bid response to Lee County for Q-060449 Traffic Cable and Installation.
 - b. Several months prior to public release of the Lee County Q-060449 RFQ, Kent began the standard Corning EWP membership application process and manufacturer training in preparation for a large Corning Fiber installation project at Ave Marie University.
 - c. Based on available Corning program options, Kent's training, BICSI certifications and substantial fiber experience, Corning agreed to extend interim Extended Warranty Program membership and program authorization to Kent to bridge the standard application process. Terms of this agreement included Kent's use of Corning Engineering Services as needed in addition to trained Kent personnel. Additionally, Kent agreed to provide any additional training or documentation that may be requested by Corning.
 - d. Under our Extended Warranty Program agreement, Kent receives the same authorization and support from Corning as any other EWP member. Accordingly, Kent is able to provide Corning product installations and extend EWP to customers for projects and installations that are eligible for coverage under Corning's warranty programs.
 - e. Kent and Corning directly discussed the Corning EWP and training related requirements as outlined in the Lee County Q-060449 RFQ prior to submission of Kent's bid response. Corning agreed that, under the terms of our agreement, Kent would meet the "Extended Warranty Partner" qualification criteria, which we interpreted to mean more correctly "Extended Warranty Program." However, Kent also learned that EWP members are not allowed to offer the extended warranty program for the subject RFQ and related traffic control system installations (See paragraph-5 below). Corning advised the only possibility of obtaining an extended warranty (if

"Enabling Information to Flow at the Speed of Business" available at all) must be offered directly by Corning and requires direct engagement of their Engineering Services resources.

- f. The use of Corning's Engineering Services was clearly available and congruent with our EWP agreement, so Kent's position was that our approach of using Corning's Engineering Services as needed was one that more closely approached the EWP requirement and intended warranty benefit of the RFQ than what an EWP member could independently offer.
- g. Printed copies of Extended Warranty Program member certificates are not issued by Corning until completion of the entire standard Extended Warranty Program process. However, Corning may provide to Kent, on a customer-by-customer basis, letters (Exhibit-3 and 4) that clearly confirm the following:
 - "Kent Technologies is a Corning Systems LANscape Solution Extended Warranty Program (EWP) member certified for installations with a stated customer"
 - ii. "The warranty extended by Kent Technologies assures installation owners that their fiber-optic cabling solution, built from high quality Corning Cable Systems products and installed by certified EWP member, provides the optical transmission bandwidth specified by ANSI/TIA/EIA-568 over an extended period of time."
- h. Since the traffic control fiber optic cable systems associated with Q-060449 are not eligible for coverage by an EWP member, Corning could not offer a letter confirming Kent's EWP membership and authorization to provide an extended warranty for the subject installations. Additionally, Kent intended to utilize Corning Engineering Services on this engagement per our EWP agreement with Corning and to facilitate any possibility of obtaining an extended warranty for the subject traffic control related installations. Therefore, Kent submitted a letter with our bid response advising the same.
- i. Kent has continued to meet the terms our agreement, including the use of Corning Engineering Services where applicable and obtaining all requisite Corning training and certifications.
- 5. Pursuant to Corning's EWP rules, <u>no</u> Extended Warranty Program member is eligible to authorize or offer the EWP for projects or systems other than those installed in a Private Network or as a Premise Cabling Solution. Specifically, installations that are part of Lee County's Traffic Control Systems, ATMS or ITS communication infrastructures are not eligible for coverage under the Corning EWP. Therefore, notwithstanding Kent's authorization to participate in the Extended Warranty Program as member and our approval to offer the Corning EWP as clarified in item four above, we further contend that the EWP requirement is not congruent or applicable with respect to the RFQ intent and purpose. Accordingly, a

rejection of our bid response based on the EWP requirement itself would needlessly and unfairly exclude Kent from an opportunity to service Lee County and overly restrict our ability to perform work on a contract that we are fully trained, qualified and experienced to do.

6. Kent Technologies' grand total price, as indicated in the bid tabulation sheet, dated July 18, 2006, is substantially less than all competing vendors. (See Exhibit 5.)

Requested Relief

Kent does have an Extended Warranty Program in effect and is in full conformance with all other requirements set forth in the RFQ. Therefore, we strongly contend that, as the lowest responsive and qualified bidder, Kent Technologies should be the primary award on contract #Q-060449 for Traffic Cable and Installation.

We certainly value our relationship with Lee County Government and we appreciate the opportunity to review this matter and share additional facts, information and clarification relevant to the RFQ, our quotation and award. I look forward to discussing the issues in more detail with Dispute Committee. Please do not hesitate to contact me should you have any additional questions in the meantime.

Program Explanation for Installation Owners

Introduction

Corning Cable Systems LLC, a leading manufacturer of fiber optic cabling products, developed the Corning Cable Systems LANscape[®] Solutions Extended WarrantySM Program in 1989 with major revisions in 1995 and 2002. This program is designed exclusively for installers of fiber optic cabling products for private networks or customer premises communications networks.

Under the Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Extended Warranty Program, Corning Cable Systems certifies approved installers to install Corning Cable Systems fiber optic cabling products and enables them to take advantage of other services from Corning Cable Systems.

Installer members receive a number of benefits once formally certified for membership in the Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Extended Warranty Program by completing the required materials and fulfilling program training requirements.

Extended Product Warranty for Covered Corning Cable Systems Products

Corning Cable Systems LLC ("Corning Cable Systems") warrants to the owner of the installation ("Owner"), that subject to the terms, conditions and limitations stated herein, Corning Cable Systems, at its sole option; shall repair or replace any Covered Corning Cable Systems Products installed in a Private Networks or Premises Fiber Cabling Solution by a Certified Member of the LANscape Solutions Extended Warranty Program that fail to meet Corning Cable Systems' published specification for such Covered Corning Cable Systems Products, as originally installed: The Extended Warranty ensures compliant performance of Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Products selected in accordance with ANSI/TIA/EIA-568, Commercial Building Telecommunications Cabling Standard, and ANSI/IEEE Std. 802.3, Standard for Carrier Sense Multiple Access with Collision Detection (CSMA/CD) Access Method and Physical Layer Specifications. The most current revision level for each domestic industry standard will be applicable. This extended warranty shall apply for a period of twenty-five (25) years total for installations consisting only of Covered Corning Cable Systems Products, commencing on the earlier of: the date of the completed installation (subject to final inspection and acceptance of the installation by Corning Cable Systems or a Certified Member of the Program.)

This extended warranty covers only the repair or replacement, at Corning Cable Systems' sole option, of Covered Corning Cable Systems Products and does not include any obligation to install any products or pay for any labor or other associated charges. In any event, Corning Cable Systems' obligations hereunder shall not exceed the original price of the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products.

Corning Cable Systems' warranties, obligations and liabilities, and owner's remedies stated herein are exclusive. There are no warranties, either expressed or implied, which extend beyond the face hereof; there is no warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Corning Cable Systems shall not be liable for any special, incidental, consequential or other damages, including, but not limited to, loss of profits or revenues or damage to other goods.

Additional Terms, Conditions and Limitations:

1. Installer shall complete and submit to Corning Cable Systems the Warranty Registration Form as attached to the Contract as Exhibit B within sixty (60) days after the date of completed installation. The extended warranty shall be valid only if the Warranty Registration Form is completed and returned to Corning Cable Systems within this sixty (60) day period. Installer must provide Corning Cable Systems with written notice within thirty (30) days of the discovery of any failure of the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products to make a claim under the extended warranty.







- 2. This extended warranty shall be null and void if any product failures are caused by improper installation, repairs or alterations, failure to use reasonable care in maintaining the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products, or Owner's failure to comply with all terms and conditions of the extended warranty, or if the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products are damaged by natural disasters, negligence, accident or misuse, including malfunction of other products.
- 3. Installation Owner interface and warranty claims shall be handled as provided in Exhibit D to this Contract. In addition, Corning Cable Systems and its agents shall have the right to inspect the installed Covered Corning Cable Systems Products during the term of this extended warranty.
- 4. Corning Cable Systems shall have no obligation hereunder until all bills related to the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products have been paid in full to Corning Cable Systems, members of the Program and their material suppliers.
- 5. Corning Cable Systems' failure at any time to enforce any provision hereof shall not be construed to be a waiver of such provision.
- 6. This extended warranty supersedes all other warranties related to the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products.

Definitions

"Covered Corning Cable Systems Products" shall mean new fiber optic cable, interconnection and splice hardware, mechanical splicing products and field-installable connectors listed in Corning Cable Systems' most current LANscape® Solutions Fiber Optic Products Catalog or any official supplement of this catalog released by Corning Cable Systems, in each case when supplied by Corning Cable Systems and used in a Private Networks or Premises Fiber Optic Cabling Solution. Covered Corning Cable Systems Products shall not include test equipment, fusion splicers, tool kits, patchcords/cable assemblies, free-space optics components, active components or software products.

"Private Networks or Premises Fiber Optic Cabling Solutions" shall mean the passive optical cabling components necessary to complete a permanently installed optical communications link between equipment rooms and working stations or end nodes within a commercial or industrial building or campus of buildings that are limited in scope by the definitions of the most current revision level of ANSI/TIA/EIA-568, and where the fiber cabling solution is owned and operated by the owner or tenant of the building or campus for the sole purpose of communications within the building or campus.

"Program" shall mean the Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Extended WarrantySM Program, as amended from time to time.

"Certified Member" shall mean members who have signed and submitted the Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Extended Warranty Program contract and completed the required training courses identified by Corning Cable Systems, including any updated training as may be required by Corning Cable Systems. In the event the Installer has multiple branch offices, each branch office must meet the criteria for membership into the Program.

"Trademarks" shall mean the Corning Cable Systems trade name, trademark and service and all trademarks for the Covered Corning Cable Systems Products, or any variation, abbreviation, part or any combination thereof, or similar thereto, together with all applications to register and registrations of such names or marks or any other name or mark of which notice is later provided to Installer by Corning Cable Systems.







Membership Benefits

1. Expert Assistance

Limited proposal and design engineering assistance may be made available to certified installer members of the LANscape® Solutions Extended Warranty™ Program from the fiber optics support staff at Corning Cable Systems. Our trained engineering staff can provide guidance during any phase of the private networks or premises cabling installation.

2. Support Materials

As members of the Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Extended Warranty Program, certified installers may receive support materials regarding system development and installation of Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Private Networks or Premises Fiber Optic Cabling Solutions. These materials include Corning Cable Systems' installation procedures, the industry's first fiber optic design guide, product catalogs and promotional literature.

Membership Requirements

1. Training

- Expiration of the Corning Cable Systems LANscape Solutions Extended Warranty Program Contract

4. Qualified On-site Personnel

Chris-Today is July 6th; this is the 8:30am Pre bid for Traffic Cable and Installation You'll note on the cover page; does everyone have a copy of the spec with them? If you don't have one I can give you one.

(Vendor) I kind of would like to have an extra one since I have to turn in back in (laughter)

Chris-If you notice on the first page it says that the opening date will be July 18th; 2006 at 2:30pm; it's always on Tuesdays at 2:30 and if you want to come to the opening that's fine, we will provide you with a tab sheet and you can keep a score of what's happening.

At any rate, you want to turn over to page 2, that's your GENERAL CONDITIONS that the county's boiler plate, I won't go thru everything on the first 13 pages, but the important part is on page 2 that's under

1-the SUBMISSION OF QUOTE we do have way we'd like you to submit it to us and that helps our lady at the front desk, uh, when she gets the package in realizes she's got a quotation in her hands because she has to stamp it and she has to put it in a sealed bid box; so this is why we want you to do it this way it's very helpful for us. It says under A. (reads word for word what's in the spec)

Okay now the rest of the general conditions, if you haven't seen them before you might want to look them over; but when you submit your quote I would just take all of these 12 pages and just toss the general, I don't need these back. We'll talk about what pages later on I do need.

As a matter of fact, on page 14 this begins your price proposal page. (Pages turning in background) On page 14, there's not much information here, but you want to know how soon you can start the project, and then the submittals, it says return quote pages 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 and if you look at those pages those are your basic price proposal pages and that's why we want those back; and the last page 19, it's probably the most important of all because it's your signature page.

On page 15, it does start the pricing, and the first section is called Fiber Optic Cable. IT says note, installed prices quote for the various types of cables connectors, fiber bags, fiber trays and cabinets shall include all labor as well as misc hardware etc; which may be required for turn key installation. And under Fiber Optic, uh... I won't read all those items to you, but uh, there's 11 of the first section, on page 16 goes to Hybrid Fiber; there's two items in there. Twisted pairs next section, fiber optic connections, it goes to fiber base, next section is fiber trays, and fiber internet cabinets and of course the grand total which is what we're looking for on this particular quote. Then there are some optional items for labor. It specifies the hours, normal working hours, overtime and of course anything for holidays that you may have; those are optional.

Also next page, 18, Conduit Repair has two options there. Option D –labor and repair conduit pull box connectors, etc. materials provided by Lee County DOT for conduit replacement. And option E is a labor to repair damaged fiber and or copper cable and test repair.

Next thing in the price proposal, it says is your firm interested in being considered in the local vendor preference? If you do mark it yes, there is a form in the back that you will fill out for local vendor preference. It asks are there any modifications to the quoters specifications? I hope not. I don't know why we have that in there because we're telling you what we really want, but we put it in there in the spec.

Next page 19, is the Anti-Collusion statement, we look for your signature there and please don't forget that.

Then the next page 20 begins the general information regarding this particular quote. Under SCOPE (reads word for word what's on the spec)

The next paragraph is concerning the TERM OF THE QUOTE (reads word for word what's on the spec)

Next paragraph is WORKMANSHIP (reads word for word what's on the spec) If you haven't noticed on this package, in the back, there are these attachments, A-D and A is talking about the corning cable system; B is talking about technical specifications for the installation of fiber optic cable, C talks about computerized signal systems technical provisions, D is your maintenance of traffic certificate that you'll need.

Those you can read over at your own leisure, I won't go over those, we'll be here forever.

I want you to go back to Page 21 under CERTIFICATION (reads word by word what's in the spec)

Turn over to Page 22, we have an ESTIMATED DOLLAR VOLUME (reads word for word what's in the spec)

The next paragraph might be of importance to you, it's the PRICE ESCALATION CLAUSE we know that during the course of this contract you may some needs to increase your costs and this paragraph does address that. It says (reads word for word what 's on the spec) after reading Chris- That's true, but what I would do is probably forward over to Earl Sally in DOT and folks and they'll review it and you know, if it's agreeable to them, then most likely it will be fine; no problem.

Okay, under GENERAL WORK REQUIREMENTS (reads word for word on the spec)

DESIGNATED CONTACT (reads word for word what's on the spec)

Turn over to page 23, BASIS OF AWARD (reads word for word)

Then we go over to page 25 there is a Section II here, which is VENDOR QUALIFICATIONS (reads word for word what's on the spec) A Sample of reference

page is on page 32; when I call your references, these are the questions that I'll be asking them.

Back on page 25 INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS (reads word for word what's on the page) guide is on page 30. Our Risk Mgmt will need this. If you're awarded the quote, just give this guide to whoever your insurer is because they need to follow exactly the requirements on this certificate.

If you turn over to page 26, Section III talks about the CORNING CABLE (reads word for word what's on the spec)

PIPE REPAIRS (reads word for word what's on the spec)

BICSI CERTIFICATION (reads word for word)

On page 27, it's probably one of the more important items is number 7 EMERGENCY REPAIR RESPONSE TIME (reads word for word)

LOCATION (reads word for word)

Then on page 28, is the LOCAL VENDOR PREFERENCE if you're going to claim that just fill it out. It is up to the department whether they allow Local Vendor Preference in most cases we don't'; but if they should, then it's to your benefit then you might want to fill it out.

Then on page 30 back to Insurance Requirements, page 32 Sample Reference Check form, and last page is for helping you to fill out the quotation. That's the BIDDERS CHECK LIST if you follow that, you won't have any problems. And that's about it as far as the briefing of the spec and going over what we're requiring. Like I said, Kathy Ciccarelli has done this quote before, I don't know if any of you have participated in the past, but it's essentially the same, same quote we used before. If you have any questions, you got our experts here (referring to 2 DOT technicians sitting in), I'll let them answer any questions that you may have. (Laughter in the distance)

(CONVERSATION STARTS FROM VENDOR(s) WITH DOT TECH'S AND AGENTS)

Vendor questions-First of, when did you do the previous bid?

(Kathy responds) It was done, a year ago; a little over a year ago. It was only good for one year because we only ended up with one vendor

Vendor questions-Who was the vendor

Kathy responds-Fiber Solutions

Vendor questions-Are they still under contract?

Kathy responds-they can yes, because they can continue under contract until we issue a new one.

Vendor questions-Is that the reason why you are re-bidding?

Kathy-Oh no, because it was only good for one year that was the stipulation; that was the only way we could get it approved to the Board; we do like competition; they (Board) don't like us to go with just one vendor; but we had no choice at that point.

Vendor (questioning himself) were we sleeping when that went out? Oops! (Loud laughter in background)

Chris-Yes, we (as the county) are always looking for competition.

Vendor asks- Was the same option applicable in the previous bid; the 4 year bid extension?

Chris and Kathy-No, it wasn't.

Kathy- We had to change it; it was originally, but when we couldn't qualify two people; we had actually had 3 bidders total,

Chris-It's very rare, almost all of our quotes are always one year contracts with 4 one year renewals and that's based on mutual agreement.

Vendor- so that's not in place with the previous quote?

Chris-No, most of our quotes are always one year contracts with 4 one year renewals

Vendor-But the previous one wasn't?

Kathy- Originally it was, it was, but when it came down to the end, we only could qualify one vendor, okay

Vendor-right

Kathy- and the Board does not like just one vendor, they want some competition, so they approved it for one year only.

Chris-Again, my Director was talking to me this morning and was asking if we're going to have any competition; and I guess she remembered what Kathy is saying. And I said there are two gentlemen in the meeting room, one from PCS and the other is Black Box.

Vendor-That's a start.

Chris-So, she said okay, and I said Kathy had told me Fiber Solutions had been doing it previously, that should be 3 then. At least three.

Kathy-Were your friends from Kent quote? I know they were interested, I'm surprised they-

Vendor? -I'm sure they will be bidding on this

Chris-Yes, I know we sent some stuff to them, I had their card

Vendor- They aren't EWP? Are you aware of that?

Chris-Oh, they're not an EWP

Vendor-not reporting it; will that just be evaluated there?

Chris-That will be evaluated; like that Maint. Traffic certificate, we find people have trouble getting that sometimes

Vendor-Right.

Chris-especially landscaping, they don't want to bother, not required in State law.

Vendor-I gotcha ya

Kathy-Like I said, it is a free playing field? Because this is a little different.

Vendor-yeah, we're all the same kind of company

Vendor-First of all, the extension of prices are to be based on a quantity of more?

Chris-Let's turn to that page; let's take a look at it. Fiber Optic Cable, is that a good example?

Vendor-Every one of them; there's no quantity listed

Chris? –No there's no quantity; just a per plus and stall? (Did not understand) Vendor- And then we just add up these prices to get the total?

Chris-Yes

Vendor (chuckles) I just want to make sure I understood that correct.

Chris-We get to our goal; trying to find our low bidder; a lot of times we'll do stuff just to evaluate the bid. So we can come up with the low bidder.

Vendor-Gotcha ya

Vendor-Um, in trying to price this, under; page 18; option D, Labor to repair to conduit pull boxes and connectors and then labor to repair fiber and all that. It says materials provided by Lee County, I know that in my many travels, Labor I'm assuming, is that suppose to be labor and equipment? Because equipment to do certain types of conduit

repairs is MUCH different to do labor to do other types of conduit repairs. I would hope that the type of conduit repairs we're talking about something?? Trenchery to it, we go hand dig it and put a?? in it; but I can tell you; I've had to put in drains, well points, because the conduits are 7-8 feet deep; that's a HUGE difference. It's about knowing what you're;

Chris-Its says there DOT is going to provide the materials

Vendor-That's not the equipment; you know what I'm talking about? (Probably looking at the techs?) There's a BIG difference in fixing somebody pressing full box (not sure what he said) and somebody cutting something that was direction of ordinance 6 feet deep.

Chris-According to this, all we're asking for is your labor. If they try to tell you, you have to provide equipment, well, we'll have to adhere to the spec, and we said Labor.

Vendor- I'm just getting that straight; a guy (something) my truck that's one thing, but if you got to do well points, and back hoething? That's new good; that's a bit difficult.

Kathy-yeah, this is just basic, basic, is all they want; is what your labor rate per hour.

Vendor- So the county will provide the equipment?

Kathy-Or you would provide; you would be quoting each job; okay each job is different; they realize that; so you would be out there pulling each job

Vendor-So each job is job to job basis (mumbling)

Kathy-right, they just want a basis of your labor rate

Chris-and that's an optional thing.

Kathy-yeah; if we have to call you in for something extra to do this, then they have your labor rate.

Chris- That wont' figure in the basis of the award; it's just an optional thing; the basis will be that grand total

Vendor-You mentioned; that it was for Traffic and/or other departments somewhere; is it currently used only for Traffic or are you guys running cable for other agencies?

DOT Tech-Yes, some of the fiber we're pulling will be used by other agencies with the same conduit

Vendor-Are you going under the same sheet or separate cables?

DOT Tech-We're still working that out, um, some of it will be separate cable and or separate conduits; but most of our conduits works all together

Vendor-So the idea is depends on what the use of the department is

DOT Tech-Right, depends on the security of each cable

Vendor-Right

Kathy-We also have a (mumbling) crew that does all of our computers; mumbling...

Vendor-we're very familiar with (mumbling)

Kathy-continues-cannot understand; talking too low.

Vendor-Speaking with the prices; let's go over to (pages shuffling) page 16 Fiber Bays; we got the term corning fiber bay panel with 6 connectors; can you tell me what you really mean about that?

Vendor-fiber patch cuppers; because cuppers are not connectors? Cause you have a connector right up above it.

Dot Tech?-hmm

Vendor- I'm thinking someone has helped you with the wrong terminology, I think that's what you're really talking about; but the way this reads, you're talking about a cabinet, with somebody put a 6 connectors in there.

Dot Tech?-that's a good point (mumbling...)

Vendor-We like everyone to be on the up and up; we'll help educate everybody; the cabinet and it's the receiver for the connector; which is called the cupper panel, different from the connector

Dot Tech -Big difference in product

Vendor-yes, and that's why I like to be clear on what we're talking about

Dot Tech?-That I know what you're talking about and I don't know the exact terminology

Vendor-I would suggest-

Dot Tech?-On the next page they have the rack mount with coupler panels; will that be different-

Vendor-same kind of thing, except it's fiber bay could be senses of 6 and the 12, I would suggest that that's a wall mount; It's kind of the way I read it.-but-although you got a wall mount right under here-

Dot Tech?-hmm mm

Vendor-Now there also are, just so you know, there are preterminated six fiber modules; okay; that is the coupler panel with the? Already done in the back of it; that we just place on the trunk cable-Again, different language; I'm just trying to see what you're really trying to get at so I know how to price that item properly

Dot Tech-Well we probably need a clarification on that

Chris-Okay; in order to do this; once they go back and talk to their folks, they'll have to give me a corrected page 16 and I will send out an addendum to all people who have picked up this package and I'll put an addendum up on our website so we can have a correction for page 16 and possibly I guess page 17, I think.

(A lot of mumbling; don't understand)

Vendor-Did anybody; consultant, help you guys at all? Or did you guys just go-

Kathy-mumbles something?

Dot tech? -Yeah

Dot Tech-Richard Epps did this many years ago

Kathy-mumbling-a year

Dot Tech-yeah

Kathy-just before he retired

Somebody?-you got corning specified in here, Mark? I mean talk to Lisa to get her to help you with some language, you know Lisa?

Dot Tech-Lisa??

Vendor?-Watts? She a corning rep to Florida. I would suggest she could help you; if you really want to use and you specify them everywhere, I 'm sure, they'll do it for free; they'll take a look at it and help you with some of that language

Dot Tech-hmm mm

Vendor-I could tell you how to get in touch with her if you'd like

Dot Tech?-

Chris-That might be helpful

Vendor-I mean, I'm just trying to help you-407-786-9271

Dot Tech-That's Lisa Watts?

Vendor-hmm-W-a-t-t-s, she's the corning engineer of Florida

Dot Tech??-As far as your question for fiber bays, now you're the fiber bay panels, the 6 connectors, as far as connectors, that's different terminology; than couplers?

Vendor-Probably-don't you think? I mean-

Chris-And, because we do have the opening set for July 18th, I'd need to get your revisions rather quick because I have got to send out an addendum to everyone who picked up the package-

Dot Tech-right

Chris-and I don't know how many there are; I don't think there will be too many; but

Vendor-you just four (chuckles)

Chris- Yes, maybe four, but I don't want to delay the opening; I'd like to keep it on track if I could.

Dot tech-for the 18th?

Chris-I'd certainly appreciate it if we can get back to me as quickly as possible

Vendor-I've got a couple of more questions if you don't mind. The cable specs that you have here...

Chris-What page?

Vendor-It's your Attachment A, goes right after 34, page 35, alright; when you read the top of that, the second line, (?) For halogen, that is a fiber cable that is to be used inside mostly in? Applications in computers. We're going outside; I think you'd want the DOT standard-loose? Dry blocks cable, which we're using all over DOT

Kathy-We could possibly be doing some, I think that-

Dot Tech-some inside work

Kathy-yeah; and we're just trying to cover all

Vendor-Could we just, say that we could use for everyone applies; for outside; we need to use the outside cable; but for inside; we need to use the inside cable and we can make that assumption

Kathy-right

Vendor-So can we make that assumption? Because that's a HUGE difference in price, HUGE difference in price. How do we price them?

Dot Tech-Well if you go to Attachment B- mumbling?-you just kind of

Vendor-for the installation?

Dot Tech-right

?-that way we could tell how much not to pull and all that

Dot Tech-right, they do talk about the plumbing inside; (mumbling some more) you're specifically looking at the type of cable?

Vendor-Yes because that's what we're pricing up there; and um, pricing by the cable and when you get the 288 zero halogen, I priced it out; and it's a substantial amount here.

Kathy-Most of this was based on what you would use on DOT

Vendor-I mean I'm sure it is; but it conflicts what's here

Kathy-well that was put in there for reference

Vendor-so should we just make that, in the addendum, make that reference; and then if it happens to be something; you would go out-

Chris-What would you like my addendum to cover?

Vendor-The fiber optic cable would be based on the corning loose 2 dry block mount side plans specifications

Chris-okay; you guys, want just go ahead and me give you that to the other changes you're going to make

(Vendor, dot tech, Chris-mumbling about the changes)

Vendor-you talk about; there's actually a reference in back of the spec; it talks about the installation of the cable, and it mentions in conduit, I just want to make sure that the conduit is not required in the cost of these cables; all conduits should be existing; it's way back in the DOT standards. I just want to make sure none of that is included in the cost of the cable. We do work all around that state; and there are some counties that that item includes messenger cable, if we were to go aerial cable, there's messenger cable; that's a BIG difference; that's 2 processes.

Kathy-I think that would depend on the job; so I think all they're asking for right now is cable, we're not trying to get too technical; we just wanna-

Vendor-Well, I'm getting back to what someone says back here; we got installation; but the Dot under 6-11 says something different; I want to make sure nobody comes back and points to that spec and says; oh no, it's this way you have to do that too.

Kathy-If they need to have the work; then that would be part of his job

(A lot of talking at once-can't understand)

Vendor-another one, page 17, item #29-the, what size? We recently lost a neighboring county project to one of the firms you mentioned on this very issue. You have a cable that says 288 fiber in here; what —of course a cabinet can do a 288 fiber compared to 6 fiber; is a huge difference; especially when you price it times 1; or that times 1 weighs in the whole factor; you're talking about something that's a couple of hundred dollars and something that's a thousand dollars times one. Cuts you right out of the job.

Other vendor?-so you want them to specify what size?

Kathy-we're just looking for the plain basic; we're not going fancy-

Vendor-No this is not-we got 8 different size of cable here; Is it Gene? I think Gene will agree with me, if you go to a 12 fiber bay compared to a 144 fiber bay—HUGE difference. My issue here is; if you've got a cabinet here; and then you say, hey, you've got a fiber bay; and somebody works up a work order; cause that's what we do all around we go thru our contracts with our clients; but if two of these are is a 12 fiber and we're putting in a 144 fiber on that particular project and we got an issue with that—how are we suppose to evaluate that in your bid; and be fair to our-to try to be low bid for you; I want to be low competitive bid; but in the same token I don't want to be hosed a year from now; when somebody says, Oh we're running a 144 fiber; and I put in a 12 fiber price. It's a big deal. At this point we're guessing, Gene and I.

Chris-That needs to be defined

Vendors-please; I would suggest that go from 2 items; put in a 12, 48, 96 make that four items each; it makes it real easy, Rich, if you come in a year from now you wan to do a work order; and you know you just ran a 12 fiber; you just put two of these two of those.

DOT Tech- so let's just clarify you're suggestion on-

Vendor-17? Where you got item 29, I would suggest that it reads; rack mount coupler panel, 24 fiber. Then a new line

Dot Tech-like the cable

Vendor- yes sir, exactly, something to give us-

Chris-Okay it looks like 16, 17 pages are going to need a little work on. And we need a statement about the cable.

Vendor-Also on 17, up above of Fiber trays; item 28, Ring Cut Fusion Strand; and 27 is fusion splicing per strand- does anybody why did they do that and what are they trying to get?

Dot Tech-I think the Ring Cut is a different splice than your typical cuts

Vendor-But what are you trying to get?

Dot Tech-

Vendor-It's the same thing except for the prep Rich, and what I'm trying to determine; where is item 27 to be used?

Dot Tech- as far as going in

Vendor-correct, it's the same process.

Chris-looks like 27 and 28 are a bit confusing

Vendor-yes

Dot tech-well this is kind of new as far as the ring cuts, I do know as far as, we were talking about another project; because some of the cable come in and they're cut-you know in the cabinet; another piece of cable goes out; I think the difference; as far as ring cut cable comes in it's not cut.

Vendor-That's a wrong term (don't understand what he said afterwards)

SYNOPSIS OF 9/29/06 PROTEST HEARING

At the Dispute Committee Meeting, Tom Esch and Walter Hedman from Kent Technologies, Inc. made a presentation outlining their reasons for filing the bid protest. Rodney A. Lavoie of Fiber Solutions of S.W. Florida addressed the issues raised by Kent Technologies, Inc. The Committee Members were afforded the opportunity to ask questions of the participants. A motion was then made to deny the protest and uphold the recommendation to award the quotation to Fiber Solutions of S.W. Florida as the low quoter meeting specifications. The motion was seconded and carried by a 3-0 vote of the Dispute Committee.

The issue under discussion was the lack of the Extended Warranty Partner Certificate, which the specifications required (page 27/section Corning Cable item B.).

Kent Technologies contended that they had a valid Extended Warranty Program in effect and were fully authorized to extend the Extended Warranty Program to its customers.

Fiber Solutions of S.W. Florida countered that they were the only Corning recognized Extended Warranty Program Member with an official certificate documenting this designation.

The Dispute Committee responded that Fiber Solutions was the only recognized vendor with the required certificate from Corning and that Kent Technologies only had access to engineering services available from Corning at the present time. Kent Technologies is apparently in the process of qualifying for a certificate. The Dispute Committee also addressed the issue that neither vendor saw fit to attend the pre-bid were if there was a problem with the required certificate the issues could be addressed.

It was also brought to the attention of the Dispute Committee that the Corning Website displays a list of their certified Extended Warranty Program members and the list did not include Kent Technologies, Inc.
