In order to provide intersection capacity modifications for the northbound Plantation Road approach to Colonial Boulevard, under existing road geometrics, a reduction in the northbound approach speed of 45 miles per hour to 35 miles is required to provide a design speed of 35 miles per hour. The City of Fort Myers has a 35 miles per hour zone north of Colonial Boulevard. The southbound Plantation Road posted speed of 45 miles per hour south of Colonial Boulevard shall remain.
