Studies on file: Speed Zone Study dated June 2, 2020. Del Prado Boulevard has changed its nature from a through highway to an urban arterial street. The large number of driveways and side streets serving high turnover businesses have created an environment that indicates a lower recommended speed limit. Del Prado Boulevard has a higher than expected vehicle crash rate that can be attributed to excessive speed and frequent side street conflicts. Del Prado Boulevard has double the crash rate for pedestrians and bicycles as compared to the rest of the County.
