Trucks leaving the CEMEX mine are parking/stopping along the shoulder on the north side of Alico Road, which has caused damage to the edge of pavement and creates additional dust due to trucks dropping and driving through dirty on the shoulder. Due to the maintenance and environmental impacts of this behavior, a prohibition of Parking and Stopping is recommended.
