 Steve Neff/AIM provided overview of this project as a flood reduction project. Also, mentioned build out model and allowable discharge.

 Steve Neff reviewed basic ideas of conveyance and storage.
- IV. LA-MSID Latest Relevant Studies and Documents

 Mike Cook/LA-MSID discussed southwest weirs he will provide as-builts. Mike Cook reviewed

 Harns Marsh project. Mike Cook reviewed Post Irma flooding specifics.
- V. Completed Projects Since Later Studies
 Mike Cook mentioned Mirror Lakes Phase 1 having been constructed, and Phase 2 is now
 underway. Also mentioned new S-H-2 being constructed, and West Marsh also being
 constructed. Discussed potential Dog to Hendry connection/storage project. Discussed Section
 10 property/project. LA-MSID is pursuing state legislature assistance for design funding of Dog
 to Hendry and Section 10 improvements. Discussed need for MOU between County and LAMSID for Section 10. LA-MSID has some photos and videos available for Post Irma. Discussed
 potential Moving Water South Phase 3. Discussed Carter Slough potential project including
 moving water through River Hall.
- VI. LA-MSID Best Available Data (rainfall, surface water levels, groundwater levels)

 Tim Browning/LA-MSID stated he has now provided requested data to Stephanie Long/ADA relative to rainfall, stage, and weir operation.
- VII. LA-MSID Identified Issues/Concerns, and Desired Outcomes

 See above for projects that were discussed. The potential connection from Bedman Creek to

 Carlos Waterway across an undeveloped piece of property was also mentioned by LA-MSID and

 AIM staff.

VIII. Discussion of Other Pertinent Items

LA-MSID and County staff thought the red line eastern boundary at Hendry Canal eastern side was appropriate. Flow south from Nine Mile Run into Lehigh at Buckingham Road was mentioned by LA-MSID staff; also water flowing from west into Alvin Ave. area (LA-MSID indicated that Alvin was under way for approximately 3 or 4 days).
