MEDIA UPDATE: Red tide fish kill cleanup

In additional to Parks & Recreation staff, CrowderGulf crews spent Thursday cleaning the Sanibel Causeway islands of dead fish.

Friday, the focus of the beach crews will again be the Causeway. Additionally, CrowderGulf will have two boats (each with a four-person crew) cleaning the west-facing canals of St. James City as the first priority; the east-facing canals of St. James City will be the second priority closely followed by Safety Harbor on Upper Captiva.

The county beach crews will focus on Bunche Beach on Saturday, then Boca Grande on Sunday and Monday.

The Town of Fort Myers Beach also has CrowderGulf under contract to clean its beaches and canals, as does the City of Sanibel.

The Captiva Erosion Prevention District is handling the cleanup on Captiva. District staff raked Redfish Pass to Alison Hagerup Beach Wednesday then proceeded south to Blind Pass today.

Bonita Beach is being cleaned by county Parks & Recreation staff.
